

EXPLORE

Year round events and activities are available, suiting almost all leisure and athletic interests. Whether you are staying in town or just visiting for a day, we know you'll have a great time.



Boating: Rent a boat at Independence Grove or drop your canoe and paddle down the Des Plaines River (launches provided by Lake County Forest Preserve).

Events: Over 50 days of annual events a year include *Libertyville Days*, *Car Fun on 21*, *Farmers Market*, *Dickens of a Holiday*, *David Adler Festival of the Arts* and more.

Fishing: Drop your line in at Butler Lake or at Independence Grove.

Hiking/Biking: More than 8 miles of paths traverse the Village connecting to the larger Lake County path system.

Museum: Visit the Dunn Discovery Museum, the Cook Victorian Home & Historical Museum, and the David Adler Estate.

Parks: 500 acres of parkland feature lakes, athletic fields, ice skating, flower gardens, picnic areas, and more.

Sports Facilities: Athletic fields are available for nearly every sport at numerous parks and indoors at the Libertyville Sports Complex.

Swimming: Take a dip at the Adler or Riverside Pools, or jump in the lake at Independence Grove Forest Preserve.

Winter: Cross-country ski through Independence Grove or along area paths, slide down the Adler Park sled hill, or ice skate at the outdoor rink.
